

FUNDING YOUR PILOT TRAINING

Federal Financial Aid

L3Harris is approved to offer Federal Financial Aid that could cover up to 100% of the cost of flight training, for those who qualify. We offer:

Federal Pell Grants:

Unlike a loan, Federal Pell Grants do not have to be repaid except under certain circumstances. Usually only awarded to undergraduate students who have not earned a bachelor's or a professional degree. Pell Grants are considered a foundation of Federal Financial Aid, to which aid from other federal and non-federal sources might be added.

Federal Direct Stafford Loan Program:

Direct Stafford Loans are low-interest loans for eligible students to help cover the cost of higher education at a trade, career, or technical school. Eligible students borrow directly from the U.S. Department of Education at participating schools. Subsidized and unsubsidized Stafford loans are available for those who qualify.

Federal Direct Plus Loan - For Parents:

Parents of dependent students may apply for a Direct PLUS Loan to help pay their child's education expenses as long as certain eligibility requirements are met. Maximum loan amount is the cost of attendance, minus any other financial aid received

To apply students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form quoting the L3Harris Flight Academy School code **041571**. studentaid.gov

- > Maximum loan amount: \$100,000
- > 7 year maximum to repay, payments begin as soon as funds are disbursed
- > International students that can show two years of U.S. tax history in the U.S. are eligible to apply, if you do not meet this requirement a cosigner would be needed that does

American Airlines Credit Education Loan

- > Must be an eligible member of American Airlines Credit Union
- > Membership is open to anyone working in the Air Transportation Industry and their families
- > Must pass credit criteria
- > Can borrow up to \$40,000
- > Repayment up to 10 years

We Florida Financial (WeFly)

- > Must be Florida resident or a member with AOPA
- > Can borrow up to \$30,000
- > 6-year repayment term

New Jersey Class Loan

- > NJ residents attending out-of-state schools
- > Must pass credit criteria
- > Borrow up to total cost of education
- > Repayment terms 10, 15 or 20 years

Vermont Advantage Student Loan

- > Vermont residents attending out-of-state schools
- > Borrow up to total cost of education
- > Must apply with a credit-worthy co-signer
- > Co-signer release may be available upon request to borrowers who meet VSAC's credit criteria after 48 months of active repayment
- > Origination fee based on co-signer's credit
- > 15 year repayment

Kentucky Advantage Education Loan

- > Kentucky residents attending out-of-state schools
- > No fees, unless postponed repayment plan is chosen (3%)
- > Borrow up to total cost of education
- > 15 year repayment

Alaska Supplemental Education Loan (ASEL)

Alaska Family Education Loan (FEL)

- > Alaska residents attending out-of-state schools
- > Loan limit of \$10,000 per year
- > Aggregate limit of \$56,000
- > Repayment term: 10 years

Veterans Administration

benefits.va.gov | + 1 888 442 4551

- > Flight Training is available to eligible veterans and reservists under Chapter 30, 32, and 33, Title 38 USC and Chapter 1606, Title 10 USC
- > L3Harris Airline Academy is considered to be a "Vocational Training Institution" by the VA
- > Montgomery GI Bill (Chapter 30 reimbursed up to approximately 60% (not including Private rating)
- > Post 911 GI Bill (Chapter 33) - reimbursed the annual limit (contact our Financial Aid Department for the current years limit)
- > Not eligible for housing allowance or book stipend

Florida National Guard: Education Dollars for Duty (EDD)

- > Florida EDD program is available to Florida National Guard Soldiers and Airmen
- > If eligible, EDD can only be used towards approved courses at L3Harris
