



# PRIVATE PILOT LICENCE (PPL) TRAINING

Become a private pilot with our PPL training in Sanford, Orlando Florida, consisting of 45 hours in a single-engine aircraft and 5 hours Night Rating. Accommodation is included.

Future pilots taking the modular route to earn their Airline Transport Pilot Licence (ATPL) need to hold a PPL prior to starting their ATPL Theoretical Knowledge training.

## Key elements of the training:

- > **Duration:** 15 weeks
- > **Location:** Sanford, Orlando, Florida, U.S.A.
- > **Required experience:** Little or none
- > **Training:** Single-engine piston aircraft

## Successful graduation from this programme will provide you with:

- > PPL
- > 45 hours total in single-engine aircraft (up to 35 hours dual flight instruction & a minimum of 10 hours of supervised solo flying)
- > 5 hours Night Rating (1 hour is completed solo)

## Entry criteria

To apply for this programme, you must meet the following requirements:

### Age and height

Aged 17 to apply and at least 18 to commence training.

Minimum height 5 ft. 2 in. (157 cm).

Maximum height 6 ft. 3 in. (191 cm).

### Education and English language

Fluent in English (spoken and written).

Non-native English speakers must achieve at least level 5.5 in all sections of the International English Language Training System (IELTS).

### Medical

UKCAA or EASA unrestricted Class 2 Medical.

### Visa

M-1 Student Visa for your flight training in the U.S.A.

### Background and selection

Cut-e testing and competency interview

Selection is mandatory and consists of technical and non-technical elements. The technical elements will test skills such as numeracy and aptitude, with the non-technical element in the form of a competency interview
